



Condor Opens a Base in Vienna with Daily Flights to Frankfurt and Direct Flights to Mediterranean Destinations

Strong impetus for two international flight hubs: The German airline Condor is stationing an aircraft at Vienna Airport for the first time and is thus expanding its presence in Austria. Starting today, the airline operates daily flight service connecting the Austrian capital and the airline's main airport hub of Frankfurt. Accordingly, new transfer possibilities for passengers to access the airline's international route network are available. Condor serves 60 global destinations from Frankfurt, including Barbados, Johannesburg, Seattle, Zanzibar and more. Moreover, Condor operates direct flights from Vienna Airport to attractive holiday destinations such as Palma de Mallorca, Kos and Rhodes in the summer season. The new base in Vienna was officially opened within the context of a photo session with Christian Lesjak, Sales Director Condor and Julian Jäger, Joint CEO and COO of Flughafen Wien AG.

"The new Condor base brings travellers closer to global holiday destinations! Passengers can now conveniently reach the airline's intercontinental route network via the Frankfurt flight hub. In turn, this noticeably expands the flight offering from Vienna Airport. The fact that Condor is permanently stationing one of its iconic aircraft in Vienna featuring a striped design is the visible expression of our successful collaboration and benefits Austria as a tourism location," says Julian Jäger, Joint CEO and COO of the Vienna Airport operating company Flughafen Wien AG.

"The daily flight connection between Vienna and Frankfurt not only connects our passengers from Austria to Condor's long-haul route network departing from Frankfurt but is also a good alternative for city and business travellers who would like to travel to the Austrian capital. Vienna is an important market for us with considerable potential where we have a valuable and reliable partner, namely Vienna Airport. Accordingly, the stationing of our first aircraft in Vienna is an important step towards expanding our offering targeting tourists from Austria's largest airport," states Christian Lesjak, Sales Director at Condor.

New base in Vienna: Condor flies daily to Frankfurt and to popular holiday destinations

Germany's largest holiday airline deploys an Airbus A320-200 aircraft for its daily flight on the Vienna-Frankfurt route. The aircraft departs from Frankfurt at 2:35 p.m. and arrives in Vienna at 4:05 p.m. The return flight leaves Vienna Airport at 7:40 a.m. and lands in Frankfurt at 9 a.m. Starting in October 2025, the airline will operate two flights each day connecting the two cities. In this way, passengers in Vienna not only benefit now from a new direct flight connection to one of Europe's biggest international transfer airports but also a convenient morning connection for business trips and overseas travel. In addition to Frankfurt, Condor also operates flights to popular holiday destinations from Vienna Airport in the summer flight schedule, namely Palma de Mallorca, Kos and Rhodes.

Condor has been bringing passengers to the most beautiful holiday destinations and exciting metropolises since 1956. Each year more than eight million guests fly with Condor to about 70 destinations across the globe from airports in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Condor operates a fleet of more than 50 aircraft for which maintenance work is carried out at the Frankfurt and Düsseldorf flight hubs in accordance with the highest safety standards by the airline's own aircraft maintenance company, Condor Technik GmbH. In 2024, Condor concluded the modernisation of its long-haul fleet which now consists of 18 efficient long-haul Airbus A330neo aircraft. Three additional A330neo jets will be added to the Condor fleet by the year 2028. Furthermore, Condor has been upgrading its entire short-haul and medium-haul fleet since 2024 and will receive a total of 43 new
