

SkyUp Airlines new to Vienna Airport: Direct flights to Chişinău from summer 2027

More flight options from Vienna to Eastern Europe: With the start of the 2027 summer flight schedule, SkyUp Airlines will launch a new service between Chişinău and Vienna, marking the airline's first presence at Vienna Airport. The route will be operated twice weekly, on Thursdays and Sundays, with a Boeing 737. The new connection will provide additional travel options between Austria and Moldova and is also important for travellers to and from Ukraine: Since the closure of Ukrainian airspace to civil aviation, Chişinău has become an important international departure and arrival point for Ukrainian travellers due to its geographical proximity. At the same time, Moldova – still a relatively undiscovered tourist destination offering authentic culture, diverse landscapes and traditional wine regions – will become more easily accessible from Vienna.

“With SkyUp Airlines, we are welcoming a new airline partner to Vienna and further expanding our flight offering to Eastern Europe. Every additional flight strengthens Vienna's international connectivity and broadens our route network. The additional flights to Chişinău provide our passengers with greater choice, improve connections to Moldova and expand travel options to and from Ukraine. Twice-weekly flights from Vienna to Chişinău with SkyUp Airlines

Starting with the 2027 summer flight schedule, SkyUp Airlines will connect Chişinău with Vienna twice a week. Flights are scheduled to operate on Thursdays and Sundays. The flight will depart Chişinău at 9:55 a.m. and arrive in Vienna at 10:40 a.m. The return flight will leave Vienna at 11:40 a.m. and arrive in Chişinău at 2:25 p.m. Services will be operated with a modern Boeing 737 aircraft.

Chişinău – a vibrant capital between tradition and new beginnings

Chişinău is Moldova's political, economic and cultural centre. Wide boulevards, spacious parks, museums and a diverse culinary scene shape the character of the capital. At the same time, Chişinău serves as a starting point for journeys to Moldova's wine regions and the country's renowned underground wine cellars. Moldova remains something of an insider tip for travellers, offering the opportunity to experience authentic culture, untouched landscapes and living traditions away from the major tourist crowds. Chişinău currently also plays a particularly important role for travellers whose destination or point of origin is Ukraine. As Ukrainian airspace remains closed to civil aviation, many Ukrainian travellers use airports in neighbouring countries for their international air travel.
